Citizenship by Right of Abode in Ghana

What Is the Right of Abode?

The <u>Right of Abode</u> allows eligible individuals to live in Ghana indefinitely, enter without a visa, and work without a work permit. It is granted by the <u>Minister for the Interior</u> with <u>Presidential approval</u>, in accordance with <u>Section 17 of the Immigration Act</u>, 2000 (Act 573).

This status is available to:

- Ghanaians who lost their citizenship after acquiring another nationality, and
- Persons of African descent in the Diaspora who can demonstrate a contribution to Ghana's development.

Step 1 - Confirm Your Eligibility

You may apply for the Right of Abode if you meet one of the following:

1. You are a **Ghanaian by birth or <u>descent</u>** who lost citizenship after naturalizing in another country; or

2. You are a **person of African descent** living abroad and can show meaningful social or economic contributions to Ghana.

Step 2 - Obtain and Complete the Application Form

- Forms are not available online.
- You must obtain the prescribed application form in person at the Ghana
 Immigration Service (GIS) Headquarters in Ridge, Accra, or any designated GIS office.

Step 3 – Prepare the Required Documents

A. For Former Ghanaians (Now Using a Foreign Passport)

- Completed application form (issued by GIS)
- Two identical passport-size photos
- Personal application letter requesting Right of Abode
- Attestation from two Ghanaians of standing (Notary, Lawyer, or Senior Public Officer) with copies of Ghana IDs
- Copy of your foreign passport (bio-data page)
- Copy of any current Ghana residence permit page
- Evidence of property ownership in Ghana (if applicable)
- Renunciation certificate or evidence showing you previously held Ghanaian citizenship
- Autobiography or brief personal history
- Birth certificate proving Ghanaian origin
- Current Ghana Police Clearance Certificate
- Copy of your valid Non-Citizen Ghana Card

B. For Persons of African Descent in the Diaspora

- Completed application form (issued by GIS)
- Application letter from you or your sponsor
- Two attestation letters from Ghanaians of repute (with Ghana ID copies)
- Evidence of contribution to Ghana's development (e.g., shares, investments, bank statements, proof of employment creation)
- Current Ghana Police Report
- · Copy of valid Non-Citizen Ghana Card
- Company documentation if applying through a business (Company registration, Tax Clearance Certificates, SSNIT records, audited accounts)
- Medical report from the Ghana Immigration Service Clinic

Step 4 - Submit Your Application

GIS conducts background verification and forwards your file to the **Minister for the Interior** for final approval.

Step 5 - Pay Applicable Fees

As of the most recent GIS schedule:

- **Ghanaians with foreign passports:** Approx. GH¢ 1,940 (about US\$ 200)
- Other nationals of African descent: Approx. GH¢ 3,879 (about US\$ 400)

Fees are **subject to change**. Always verify current charges on the official GIS website: https://gis.gov.gh/fees-and-charges/

Step 6 - Processing Time

Applications typically take around **six (6) months** to process after GIS submits its report to the Ministry.

Timelines vary by individual case.

Step 7 - Issuance of Certificate

Once approved, the Ministry issues a **Right of Abode Certificate**.

This certificate grants indefinite residence, visa-free entry, and the right to work in Ghana without a separate work permit.

It is not equivalent to citizenship but provides similar residency benefits.

Step 8 - Entry and Health Requirements

If entering Ghana for the first time:

- You must present a Yellow Fever vaccination card.
- The vaccine is required for entry and costs around US \$300 in the U.S. (at CVS, Walgreens, or local health departments) and about US \$25 in Ghana.
